## **Pricing Role**

- Statistical strengths combined with judgement
- Interest in detail
- Interest in computers
- Dynamic
- Problem solving
- Nature of the role depends on the organisation
  - Access to 'customers'
  - Price-only vs product/price/underwriting
  - Variety products, projects, focus points
  - Part vs All of control cycle
  - Report writing



## **Statutory Role**

- May involve statistical strengths
- Judgement
- Interest in accuracy
- Report writing
- Seasonal and deadlines
- Usually standards to adhere to



#### **Data Role**

- Computer and systems focus
- Manipulating volumes of data
  - Feature creation
  - Structured vs unstructured
- Creativity, Elegance
- Alchemy?
- May be 'unbounded' (more like research role) vs focused on specific deliverables



## **Management Role**

- Project delivery time/budget/result
- Customer management
- Team management
- Guiding work direction
- Designing processes
- Accountability
- Removal from technical detail and 'real data'

- Full circle?
- Variety within company vs across customers/industry
- Time sheets & billable hours
- Employer focus
- Growing the business
- Employee vs Employer
